Conditions and pre-requisites

The training is available to holders of a master in medicine and a specialised master in surgery (or students in at least their fourth year of this specialisation).

Knowledge of English is compulsory.

Courses programme

1. Preparatory work (165 hours of student work - 5 credits)

- a. Review of human anatomy, with particular respect to musculo-skeletal and vascular anatomy
- b. International Humanitarian Laws - IHL (ICRC e-learning training Center)

- e. Manuel de Chirurgie humanitaire

2. Humanitarian Surgery Course (130 hours - 5 ECTS) :

- a. 90 hours of face-to face classroom ; 3 credits
- b. 45 hours of student work for subject approval ; 2 credits
- c. 5 hours of student knowledge assessment
