Presentation

The University training certificate in management and organisation of General Medicine within Primary Healthcare prepares for an analysis of a healthcare system and its improvement depending on the needs of the population. This training includes theory classes, meetings with front line professionals, documentary research, and seminars as well as drafting and presenting analytical work on the student's national health system.

Special conditions of access / students concerned

This training is aimed at students holding a 2nd cycle degree in the field of health (doctors, pharmacists, Masters in public health, Masters in biomedical sciences, etc.). Applicants not meeting these conditions will be examined by the coordinator on the basis of a more extensive application file. Classes will be given in French.

Duration

The entire training of 15 ECTS lasts one month.
